



12th-Albatross International Golf Championship, India-2021

FACT-SHEET

1. **DATES:** December 01 to 03, 2021 (Wednesday - Friday)
2. **VENUE:** Classic Golf & Country Club, Gurgaon (Delhi-NCR)

3. **FORMAT:** 54 Hole Stroke Play (Gross Score). Individual Championship.

4. **Conduct of Tournament:**

Ridge/Valley Sub-course's: Category AA, A, B & C (Boys & Girls)
Canyon Sub-Course: Category D & E (Boys & Girls)

5. **Age Eligibility/Criteria:** All players conforming in all aspects to the Rules of Amateur Status as laid down by the R & A between the ages of 6 – 23 years (must have completed 6th birthday as on **December 1** & not have reached the 24th birthday as per the cut-off date as specified below) are eligible to play. A player's age as on **December 3, 2021** will determine his/her age category, for the tournament. Entries are accepted online only on www.albatross.co.in **last date midnight, November 27, 2021.**

6. **Withdrawal/Refund Policy:** An entry fee will only be refunded wherein a written request / mail is received from the player seeking withdrawal/cancellation of their entry". **Last date for cancellation/seeking refund is November 28, 2021.** There is no Refund once an entrant has "Teed Off" or for 'No Shows'. Refunds are governed by AJT policy on subject.

7. **Player Registration:** Registration is mandatory, and all Players are required to register/check in, at the Registration Desk, set up at the Club House Terrace, from **0900 to 1500 H, on November 30th** (Tuesday).

8. **Optional/Paid Practice Round:** An optional practice round has been scheduled on **November 30, 2021**, on self-payment by players (Rs 750/- Green Fee & Rs 850/- caddie fee plus GST), on first come first served basis. Players are required to book their practice round directly with the Pro shop (+91-99999-96099) at CGR. Players may use golf carts for the said practice round. Players under 16 Years are prohibited to drive the golf carts. **All players are required to vacate the course by 1630 H.**

9. **Tee Posts/Markers:** Categories AA, A, B and C will play the Ridge – Valley Course. Categories D & E will play the Canyon Sub-Course.

Black Tees	:	Category AA, A & B Boys (Counting for WAGR)
Blue Tees	:	Category AA, A & B Girls (Counting for WAGR)
White Tees	:	Category C Boys
Red Tees	:	Category C Girls
Canyon White Tees	:	Category D Boys
Canyon Red Tees	:	Category D Girls
Canyon Fairway Tees	:	Category E (Boys & Girls)

10. **Draw & Tee Offs:** Tee offs for all cats, shall commence (staggered start) from Tee No's 1 & 10 (Ridge/Valley) at 0700 H and Tee No 1 (Canyon) at 0800 H, as per Draw. Draw for Day 1 (as determined by AJT/TD) shall be posted online (www.albatross.co.in) & posted on the Tournament Notice Board by 1400 H on November 30, 2021. Draw for Day 2 & 3 will be based as per gross scores. The Tournament Director reserves the right to alter the draw and change the grouping to facilitate smooth conduct of the tournament.

11. **Time of Reporting / Starting:** A player is responsible for finding out his / her starting time from the host club / www.albatross.co.in. **All players are required to report at their respective Tee / Starter's Desk 15 minutes before their scheduled tee off time. Player's failure to report at the tee beyond 5 minutes of starting time shall lead to DISQUALIFICATION. (Note Rule 6 – 3a).**

12. **Applied Cut:** A Cut will be applied after 2 days for Cat's AA, A, B & C. Players exceeding gross scores as below, over 2 rounds would not be permitted to take further part in the tournament.

13. **Recording of Scores:** All score cards (issued by the Tournament Committee) must be completed and signed in pen. The correct recording of scores will be the responsibility of the players, as per the Rules of Golf 6-6; each player will be assigned a "marker" to record the score of another player in the same group. A card is deemed to have been submitted once the player leaves the "Scoring Area".

14. **Scoring Area:** is located in the Club House Terrace, adjacent to CGR & CC Pro-shop.

15. **Caddie Policy:** Caddies are mandatory for all categories. A player is prohibited from having Parents / relatives / professional golfer/ coaches, another player in the competition serves as his caddie during the stipulated round. **Use of Outside/Pvt caddy is permitted during the tournament. A parent may caddie for a player of Cat D & E.** Caddie Fee per round of Rs. 1005/- for 18/9 holes, is payable directly to the host club (Pro-shop). Manual push/pull carts are permitted (non-motorized & non-battery operated). Players availing services of a Pvt/outside caddies must provide proof of vaccination record/certificate of caddie. Due limited availability of caddies at the host venue, priority will be given to outstation players (not residing in NCR)

16. **Spectator Policy:** Gallery / spectators are permitted to walk on the course and are restricted to the cart path/tree line / roughs and must maintain a distance of 25 meters from the players and also to take care not to obstruct any player. Gallery is not permitted to interact / advise / instruct / interfere with any player. First violation: verbal warning; second infringement: 2 stroke penalty to the player involved and

spectator removed from the course. Gallery must follow laid down Covid Protocols. **Spectators are not permitted to ride carts unless authorized by the TC.**

17. **Local Rules:** of the host course will apply. A copy of the local rules will be made available to all players.

18. **Electronic Policy/Mob Phones:** Use of mobile phones is permitted during the stipulated round for **a medical emergency or to call a rule official only.** Players may carry the mobile (in switch off mode) and may use the same for the above purposes only **after prior intimation of intended use to marker or fellow competitor.** First violation: warning; second infringement: 2 stroke penalty. Subsequent violations-DQ.

19. **Distance Measuring Devices (DMD):** Players may use DMD during the stipulated round (**limited to measuring distance only.**) In this competition, a player may obtain distance information by use of distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is two strokes, and DISQUALIFICATION for subsequent offence.
