1. **NAME OF THE TOURNAMENT:** 114thALBATROSS GOLF TOURNAMENT
2. **VENUE:** Bangalore Golf Club
3. **Dates:** Dec 23 & 24 (Thursday-Friday)

(Practice round scheduled December 22, 2021)
4. **FORMAT**
 - (a) 36 Holes Stroke Play: Category AA, A, B, C & D (Boys & Girls).
 - (b) 18 Holes Stroke Play: Category E (Boys & Girl)
5. **ENTRIES OPEN ON December 01, 2021 AND CLOSE ON December 21, 2021 (entries accepted online only).**
6. **TEE Posts/ Markers:** Category AA, A & B will play Blue tees. Category C & D will play Red tees. (Boys & Girls). Category E from Special tees.

7. **Preliminary Cut:** There is no cut. All players will play 36 Holes (Cat E will play 18 Holes).

2021 COVID-19 Guidelines for Albatross Tournaments (What to Expect When Competing This Season)

General Safety and Health Guidelines

1. All visitors must duly fill up and sign a Club issued Declaration Form on the day of the visit. The Club shall reserve the right of admission and access to the facilities determined on the basis of the information provided therein.
2. There shall also be a mandatory temperature check of all caddies and players at the site.
3. Installing of the Aarogya-Setu app is being recommended and you are also expected to regularly update your health status on it. RT-PCR test up to 3 days prior to tournament date
Vaccination certificate (if any).
4. Social Distancing (minimum of 6-foot distance from others) must be practiced at all times when at the tournament venue.
5. Masks mandatory in all areas except while playing on course and dining. This in accordance with the host club, state and MHA guidelines.
6. Frequent Sanitizing or washing of hands must be practiced.
7. Hand sanitizer will be available at starting and scoring areas.
8. Refrain from touching your face.
9. Gatherings are strictly prohibited – players will be asked to leave the property as soon as the round has been completed.
10. No handshakes, high fives or hugs.
11. Players are advised to have their own health insurance in specific with the COVID-19 coverage.
12. If a player is showing any signs of illness they will be asked to stay home and must follow the health protocols as recommended by the health authorities.

Local Club Rules to be followed:

1. Hole numbers, 6, 8, 15 and 16 are mandatory irons only holes for categories AA, A, B and C (boys and girls). Category D and E can use woods.
2. Out Of Bounds:
 - a. The course boundary defines the course. Ball beyond the fence is out of Bounds.
 - b. The club house area on the left of and beyond the green of 9th hole and to the right of 4th hole and 1st hole are out of bounds.
 - c. The parking lot area is Out of Bounds.
3. The area between the course boundary and the protective net along holes 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 15, 16, is a no play zone and player has to take mandatory penalty drop. Drop zones have been created at various intervals along the net for taking penalty drop.
4. All Yellow penalty areas are to be played as Red Penalty areas.
5. The practice net to the left of 4th hole and to the right of 18th fairway is Out of Bounds.
6. Ball resting on the net above the car park on the 4th hole fairway is out of bounds and players have to take stroke and distance penalty.

Pre-Round

1. Players are asked to arrive at the course no more than 60 minutes prior to their tee time.

2. All players are allowed caddies. Outside caddies are not allowed. Category E parent caddie is allowed.
4. There is no driving range in BGC. Only practice net is available behind the 1st Tee box. Practice net and putting greens will be monitored and social distancing will be strictly enforced.
5. In an effort to maintain Social Distancing, the Host Club may restrict the number of players on any practice putting green or chipping green. Players will be restricted to 15 minutes in the areas when other players are waiting for access.
6. Players shall get 50 balls per player complimentary for warm up on the range.
7. Only a scorecard and hole location/local rules sheet will be distributed on the tee. They will be stapled together and given from the starter to the marker. There will be no exchange of paper or score card between participants.

Starting Area

1. Players MUST report to their starting tee only 10 minutes ahead of their starting time.
2. No starter boxes with supplies available, only an official clock – players are required to bring with them their own tees, ball markers, divot tools, hand sanitizer, medicines, etc.
3. Tournament paperwork (Notice to Competitors, hole location sheets, local rules, hard card, pace of play) will be emailed to players the evening before the event.
4. Players must wear Mask and stand 6 feet apart when receiving instructions from starter.
5. Starter(s) will wear Mask.
6. Score card stapled with the hole location/local rules sheet will be provided and given by the starter to the marker from the table.
7. Hand sanitizer will be available at the starters table.

During Round

1. Regardless of their position on the golf course, Players MUST maintain six (6) feet of distance between themselves and other players. This includes when they are preparing for a shot, walking down the fairway/rough, on the teeing ground, on the putting green, and all other locations.
2. Mask/facial covering MUST be worn in accordance with the host club, state and MHA guidelines.

Flagsticks / Bunker Rakes

All participants shall not remove the flagsticks or touch bunker rakes. There shall be one person deputed by the club for each flight who shall rake the bunkers and attend the flagstick, when required. No parents/ Caddies shall be allowed on Tee Boxes and Greens.

Tournament Committee: The Tournament committee consists of the Tournament Director, The Referees, The Host Club Captain and the Club Tournament committee head.

Results /Scores

Results will be posted on the website and emailed to all participants at the conclusion of each tournament round/event.

Scoring

1. Score to be entered online by each flight after completing each hole. One player/parent/caddie will be designated who will enter scores for the flight.
2. Player to enter scores manually in their score cards for verification in case of disputes.
3. Players will be asked to leave the course upon the completion of play unless they are in contention for a prize & No practice will be allowed after the Round.

Play-Offs

If, in the event of a tie for first place in any category, there will be a "Sudden Death" play-off, hole by hole, immediately after the completion of the stipulated round. The sequence of the play-off & holes to be played will be decided by the "TD". Countback method will be used to break other Ties over the last 18,9,6,3,2,1 holes (Back Nine of the course, holes 10-18).

Prize Presentation

1. Only the Sponsor representative, Host Venue representative, Officials, Winner, Runner-up will be expected to stay for the prize presentation ceremony.
2. Trophies and awards will be displayed on tables for pick up by the recipient to take home.
3. Social Distancing (minimum of 6-foot distance from others) to be maintained & Mask/facial covering MUST be worn in accordance with the host club, state and MHA guidelines.

Weather Delays

1. Should play be suspended for inclement weather, players are encouraged to seek shelter in their cars.
2. If club house is open, players without a car can seek shelter inside the clubhouse while still maintaining social distancing.
3. Instructions to resume play will be done via text and email notifications.

Clubhouse Access

1. Restroom and pro-shop are available. No changing room access
2. Come prepared for the weather as access to all indoor facilities may be limited.

Restroom Facilities

1. Accessible restrooms will be available at the clubhouse and on course. Players / parents / caddies to ensure adequate sanitization while using the facility.

Miscellaneous

1. All players should refrain from touching their fellow competitors in any way, including shaking hands prior to and following the round.
2. Spectators will be held to the same social distancing requirements as players.

Host Club in Containment Zone

1. Should the area in which the host club is situated be declared a CONTAINMENT Zone by the authorities before start of the scheduled tournament, the tournament will be cancelled and fresh dates will be circulated.

Participant diagnosed with COVID-19 during a Tournament

1. In the unlikely, should a participant be diagnosed with COVID-19, he must inform the organizers immediately and follow all health protocols so set forth by the host club, state and the MHA.
2. The tournament under such circumstances may be cancelled as the Host Club could be declared a containment zone or the host club/state authorities may not want the tournament to continue. However, the conditions mentioned in Host Club in Containment Zone will be exercised.
3. The participant's playing partners and with those he contacted must get their COVID-19 tests done so to know whether or not they have contacted the COVID-19.

Liability Waiver

1. All participants are required to sign the Participant Consent Form before being permitted on site or allowed to participate; Anyone refusing to sign the consent will not be allowed participation.

While we appreciate the cooperation of all participants in adhering to these guidelines thus enabling us, the sponsors and the host club make the tournament experience an enjoyable one for all.
