FACT SHEET

The Fact Sheet is required to be read in conjunction with the Albatross Golf Tour (AGT), HARD CARD uploaded on www.albatross.co.in

1. **NAME OF THE TOURNAMENT:** 115thALBATROSS GOLF TOURNAMENT
2. **VENUE:** Jaypee Greens Wishtown, Noida
3. **Dates:** March 24 & 25 (Thursday-Friday)
(An optional paid Practice round scheduled on March 23, 2022)
4. **FORMAT**
 - (a) 36 Holes Stroke Play: Category AA, A, B, C & D (Boys & Girls).
 - (b) 18 Holes Stroke Play: Category E (Boys & Girls)
5. **ENTRIES OPEN on February 10th and ENTRIES CLOSE on March 21, 2022 (entries accepted online only).**
6. **Age Eligibility/Criteria:** All players conforming in all aspects to the Rules of Amateur Status as laid down by the R & A between the ages of 6 – 23 years (must have completed 6th birthday as on **March 24** & not have reached the 24st birthday as per the cut-off date as specified below) are eligible to play. A player's age as on **March 25, 2022** will determine his/her age category, for the tournament. Entries are accepted online only on www.albatross.co.in **last date midnight, March 21, 2022.**
7. **Withdrawal/Refund Policy:** An entry fee will only be refunded wherein a written request / mail is received from the player seeking withdrawal/cancellation of their entry". **Last date for cancellation/seeking refund is March 21, 2022.** There is no Refund once an entrant has "Teed Off" or for 'No Shows'. Refunds are governed by AJT policy on subject.
8. **Practice Round:** An optional paid practice round has been scheduled on **March 23, 2022,**

on self-payment by players (Rs 1200/- special Green Fee), on first come first served basis. Players are required to book their practice round directly with host Club. Players may use golf carts (if available) for the said practice round. Players under 16 Years are prohibited to drive the golf carts. **All players are required to vacate the course by 1630 H.**

9. **Caddie Policy:** Caddies are mandatory for all categories. A player is prohibited from having Parents / relatives / professional golfer/ coaches, another player in the competition serves as his caddie during the stipulated round. **Use of Outside/Pvt caddie is permitted during the tournament. A parent may caddie for players of Cat's D & E only.** Caddie Fee per round of Rs. 600/- for 18 holes. Manual push/pull carts are permitted (non-motorized & non-battery operated).
10. **Draw & Tee Offs:** Tee offs for all categories, shall commence from Tee No.1 from 0830 Hrs. The Draw for Day 1 (as determined by AJT/TD) shall be posted online on the Website & Notice Board by 1700 H, on March 23, 2022. Draw for Day 2 will be based as per gross scores. The Tournament Director reserves the right to alter the draw and change the grouping to facilitate smooth conduct of the tournament.
11. **TEE Posts/ Markers:** Category AA, A, B, C & D will play 18 holes, Category E (Boys & Girls) will play 9 holes, each day/stipulated round (front 9 of course only). Total yardage for each division is as follows:

Blue Tees	:	5000 Yds:	Category AA, A & B (Boys), Cat AA & A (Girls)
White Tees	:	4600 Yds:	Category C Boys, Cat B Girls
Red Tees	:	4000 Yds:	Category D (Boys), Cat C Girls
Yellow Tees	:	3600/1900 Yds:	Category D (Girls), Category E (Boys & Girls)

12. **Time of Reporting / Starting:** It is the responsibility of the individual Player to find out his/her starting time from the web site/ host club / www.albatross.co.in . All players are required to report at respective Tees/Starter's desk 10 minutes before their respective Tee-Off time. The Player must start at (and not before) his or her starting time.

Penalty for Breach of Rule 5.3a: Disqualification, except in these three cases:

- **Exception 1 – Player Arrives at Starting Point, Ready to Play, No More Than Five Minutes Late:** The player gets the **general penalty** applied to his or her first hole.
- **Exception 2 – Player Starts No More Than Five Minutes Early:** The player gets the **general penalty** applied to his or her first hole.
- **Exception 3 – Committee Decides that Exceptional Circumstances Prevented Player from Starting on Time:** There is no breach of this Rule and no penalty.

- 13. Preliminary Cut:** There is no cut. All players will play 36 Holes (Cat E will play 18 Holes).
- 14. Spectator Policy:** Gallery/spectators are permitted to walk on the course during a stipulated round. Carts are not permitted for spectators. Spectator support is appreciated at all Albatross events and all are encouraged to follow the competition. Gallery/spectators are restricted to the designated areas of Club House/ Driving Range/cart path/rough/tree line (remain clear of Fairways & Greens) and are advised to maintain a minimum distance of 25 yards (approx.) from the players. Spectators are advised to keep their mobiles/phones on silent mode and where necessary, must step aside to take/make calls, taking care not to disturb any player in the process of making a swing/shot or putt. Spectators are not permitted to interact/advice/instruct/interfere with any players during the stipulated round. Under no circumstances is a spectator allowed to offer advice to a contestant during the round.

First violation: Verbal warning,

Second infringement: 2 stroke penalty to player and spectator removed from course.

- 15. Recording of Scores:** All score cards (issued by the Tournament Committee) must be completed and signed in pen. The correct recording of scores will be the responsibility of the players, as per the Rules of Golf 6-6; each player will be assigned a “marker” to record the score of another player in the same group. A card is deemed to have been submitted once the player leaves the “Scoring Area”.

- 16. Electronic Policy/Mob Phones:** Use of mobile phones is permitted during the stipulated round for a medical emergency or to call a rule official only. Players may carry the mobile (in switch off mode) and may use the same for the above purposes only after prior intimation of intended use to marker or fellow competitor. First violation: warning; second infringement: 2 stroke penalty. Subsequent violations-DQ.
- 17. Distance Measuring Devices (DMD):** Players may use DMD during the stipulated round (limited to measuring distance only). In this competition, a player may obtain distance information by use of distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player

uses a distance measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is two strokes, and DISQUALIFICATION for subsequent offence.

- 18. Local Rules:** of the host course will apply. A copy of the local rules will be made available to all players.
